BANNED ARTICLES

MEDICATION

No patient is allowed to keep any medication in their possession. All medication must be handed in to the nursing staff. Medication will be given to the patient as prescribed. Please make sure that the patients have enough medication for the duration of the program.

TREATMENT FEES:

R600 needs to be paid on the day of admission except if another arrangement is made with the administrative assistant. The money is utilised as follows:
