LIST OF THINGS TO BRING WITH

- Toiletries – All deodorants and aftershave alcohol free please.
- Working clothes (old clothes)
- Underwear
- Flashlight
- Mosquito Repellant (Peaceful sleep)
- Church clothes (shirt and pants)
- Shoes (neat)
- Old shoes for work
- Padlock and key
- Telephone card
- Washing powder
- Washing pegs
- *Writing pad or Book and pen, Bible + Coffee mug*
- Comforter or blanket

Pillows, sheets, towels will be provided. Patients are welcome to bring their own.

BANNED ARTICLES

TV, Computers, cell phones, walkman, weapons, alcohol and drugs.

ARTICLES ALLOWED

Radio, CD players, etc. Please note that these must be battery operated as rooms have no plugs.

MEDICATION

All medication, clinic card and if necessary, the latest prescription must all be brought and handed in to the nursing staff. Over the counter medication needs to be provided. Medication will be given to the patient as prescribed. No patient is allowed to keep any medication in his room.

SNACKS

Patients are allowed to receive parcels with snacks. All parcels will be searched for prohibited articles and substances. No cooked or tinned food is allowed in the rooms.

MAIL

Patients may receive and post letters. Mail must be handed in at reception to be posted.
