#### **Dear Patient**

We are looking forward to welcoming you at the centre. We would like to give you the following information so that you can arrive prepared. **A R1 200 patient contribution will be required at admission**.

## List of things to bring with:

- Toiletries All deodorants and aftershave must be alcohol-free
- Working clothes & shoes (old clothes)
- Church clothes & shoes (shirt & pants)
- Underwear
- Padlock and key
- Washing pegs and washing powder
- Writing pad/Book and pen (sold for R15 at reception), Bible
- Coffee mug
- Comforter/duvet or blanket

Pillows, sheets and towels will be provided. Patients are welcome to bring their own.

#### **Treatment fees:**

Treatment fees are payable as agreed. Please read the financial contract thoroughly. First payment is payable on the day of admission. A card machine is available if needed.

A patient may not have more than R250 pocket money on a weekly basis which will be paid out on a Wednesday if it shows in our bank account or was paid into reception.

#### **Medication:**

All medication, clinic card and a valid medical prescription must all be brought and handed in at the medical staff. Over the counter medication needs to be provided. Medication will be given to the patient as prescribed. No patient is allowed to keep any medication in his room.

#### Snacks:

Patients are allowed to receive parcels with snacks. All parcels will be searched for prohibited articles and substances. A 'snoepie' is also on our premises. No cooked or tinned food is allowed in the rooms.

### **Banned Articles:**

Anything electronic or electric – (including a TV, laptop, mobile phone). Also no weapons, cutlery, alcohol or drugs.
